The Daring class was first proposed in 2290 as a heavy destroyer variant of the popular Avenger Class Frigate. It mouned heavier weaponry at the expense of the science capability of the Avenger. The class was repeatedly delayed to ensure it was kept state of the art. It was originally due to be equipped with FWG-1 warp drives, but the promise of the new FWL-2 drive lead to the decision to delay the project and adopt that system.

HEAVY DESTROYER

The decision to delay the project was both a blessing and a curse. The new engine was far more powerful and fater than the FWG-1, but the delays meant the class did not begin to commission until after the beginning of détente with the Klingon empire following the negotiations at Khitomer. As a result in 2293 it was decided that only two vessels of the projected 20 would be completed, the remainder of the incomplete vessels were expended as targets or scrapped

In 2303 Starfleet felt the need to boost its defensive capability following some minor border incidents with dissident Klingon groups. The Successful Daring Class was chosen as the basis for a modified ship which was named Demon. Unlike the deep penetration roled Daring class, the Demon was designed with powerful defence as its main mission. They were intended to supplement Akyazi class perimeter action vessels. A secondary role was to act as close escorts to the Battle Frigates of the Thunder Class.

The most noticable external change was the adoption of a newer simpler nacelle for the FWL-2 warp drive.

Internally a twin M6A computer installation replaced the single M8. This had three purposes, firstly the twin installation was 50% cheaper than the M8, secondly the computers were readily available whereas using the M8 may have delayed the program. Thirdly the twin installation permitted an increase in firepower.

The Andorian designers replaced the megaphasers with four of the new FMH-11, this was primarily to increase the range of the ship's weapons. The shields, torpedoes and phasers were unchanged from the Daring class as they were already state of the art. The exploration suite was enhanced by the addition of four laboratories, unfortunately this what at the expense of some of the already limited crew facilities.

The ships saw action in the Thoilan and Cardassian conflicts before being mothballed in the 2250s. They were recalled to duty during the Dominion Conflict, acting as part of the main defences of the Andorian homeworld.
